### SWASH™ Portable Cart



The SWASH™ Portable Cart turns an Electro-Steam LG Stationary Steam Generator into a portable unit. The cart is designed so that the LG unit, as-delivered, can be easily moved onto the cart and secured using hardware provided.

### Steam In Place (SIP) Assembly



The Steam In Place (SIP) assembly allows you to turn a length of stainless steel sanitary pipe into effectively an autoclave. By applying low pressure steam at not greater than 20psi, an internal pipe temperature can be maintained in excess of 250°F (121°C) to achieve medical grade sterilization.

### Automatic Steam Controller



The SWASH™ steam controller allows for automatic on/off control to sterilize a bottling line including a filter block assembly from one steam generator without personnel present to start the process.

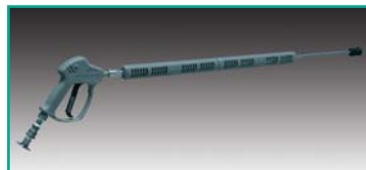
A dual controller is also available to separately sterilize the bottling line and filter block assembly if desired.

### Barrel Steam Wand



Modeled after a century old Bordeaux design, the SWASH™ Barrel Steam Wand is elegant in simplicity and functionality. Steam is uniformly and safely distributed in the barrel for effective tartrate removal and barrel sanitization. Recent evidence shows that with the technique we recommend, residual wine is removed from the pores of the wood with little or no erosion of the toast.

### General Purpose Steam Gun



The SWASH™ steam gun with its 42" lance, is long enough to safely allow steam cleaning of hard surfaces and is very effective on floor drains.

It is insulated to protect the individual using it.

### Steam Hose with Fittings



The SWASH™ hose/ fitting package is specifically designed to connect the SWASH™ steam generator to the various accessories you have purchased or directly to your equipment. The hose is steam rated to 100 psig and temperatures of up to 338°F/170°C.

It is designed for food contact, making it safe for all typical steam applications. The SWASH system includes custom sanitary connectors that serve as flow regulators, and are the only steam "Boss Clamp" compatible sanitary fittings available, further insuring safety.
